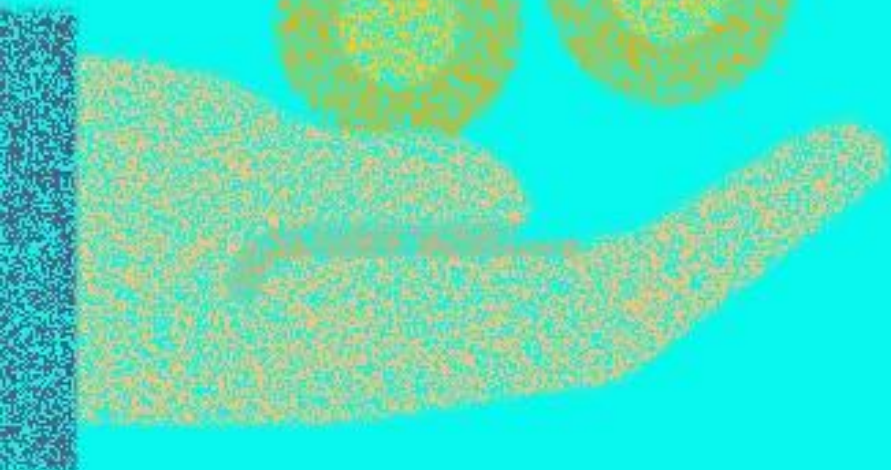

# About the Seminar

Recently, the Government of India undertook two radical policy decisions: Demonetisation and GST that are capable of transforming the course of the Indian economy. Demonetisation, followed by GST will have short term and long term effects on the Indian industry, trade, finance, banking, business structures as well as on economic growth and employment. The Centre-State financial relations, social life and polity also have been affected. The only question is what direction that course will take. A Pandora's Box of questions is opened up and new areas of research in Indian economy are emerging. The implications of demonetisation and GST are expected to be multidimensional and multi-directional but for a conclusive evaluation we will have to wait longer. Meanwhile, economists and researchers are putting their academic heads together to arrive at some predictions and preliminary results. The Economics Department of Shaheed Bhagat Singh College (University of Delhi) takes this opportunity to invite academicians, researchers, economists and professionals from across the country to share the stage and discuss their views about the strategy, justification, and implications of these two policy decisions. The discussions of the seminar will explore many new ideas for further research in these areas. It will result in certain recommendations relevant for the policy makers and the government.



The Seminar will have two technical sessions: one on Demonetisation and the other on GST. Demonetisation session will focus on the overall strategy and justification of demonetisation. It will emphasise the impact of this reform on the Indian macroeconomy; focussing on growth, employment, inflation as well as issues like the black economy, corruption, financial sector, polity and society. GST session will focus on rationale of GST as a tax reform in the Indian economic scenario; implementation problems and challenges for the corporate sector as well as its impact on the unorganised sector of the economy, thus evaluating the reform as a whole. We have the following eminent speakers:
