



Note:

1. Only those students who fulfil the eligibility conditions as per the Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgement dated 22.9.2006 accepting Lyngdoh Committee Recommendations may contest the election. They shall abide by the code of conduct for election, which come into effect with the display of this notification.
2. No candidate can contest simultaneously for more than one post. In case, a candidate files nomination for more than one post then he/she has to withdraw the nomination from more than one post failing which all his/her nominations shall stand cancelled.
3. Each candidate is required to deposit Rs. 500/- (non-refundable) as security deposit and furnish an affidavit regarding eligibility and code of conduct along with nomination form. Nomination forms can be obtained from **Mr. R.P. Singh, Sr. P.A. to Principal from 31st August, 2018 during office hours against payment of Rs. 100/-.**
4. No student shall put posters inside and outside the College premises except the hand made poster on the Wall of Democracy inside the College. Canvassing with any form of printed material may amount to disqualification.
5. Incomplete nomination papers would solely be the responsibility of the candidate and not of the College and would be summarily rejected. Therefore, students are advised to carefully check that their nomination papers are complete in all respects.
6. Students having academic arrear, i.e., failed in a Semester although promoted to the next semester are not eligible to contest election.
