

About the Centre for Writing and Communication: What do we plan to do?



English Language Support

The Centre will offer English language support to students who are comparatively unfamiliar with English through weekly classes for an Add-On course focused on English Grammar and core competencies of Listening, Writing, Reading, and Speaking.



Practice Sessions and Guided Conversation Circles

We will be running weekly guided conversation/practice circles and language buddy programs, wherein students will enter guided conversations with their classmates/peers to improve their communication and critical thinking skills. We will also offer individual consultations and personalized curation of resources (books, webpages, movies, etc.) for interested students to help them become better, confident communicators. We plan to develop a mechanism to offer each student the space to review and improve their communication pieces (e.g., assignments, papers, presentations, speeches, a piece of creative writing, etc.) or soft skills during one-on-one tutoring sessions.



Talks and Workshops on Creative Writing, Research, and Publication

With the aim of familiarizing students with the fundamentals of academic writing and encouraging them to produce a body of writing/research suitable for publication, archiving, etc., the Centre will be organizing regular workshops and lectures by professionals/experts in various allied fields as well as faculty members from various departments of the college. The Centre hopes to offer students a space to practice their creative and academic writing skills for voluntary projects with relaxed deadlines.
