Guidelines for VAC Semester IV

- 1) It is mandatory for all the students of all courses of Semester IV to choose their options for Value-Added Course (VAC) for the 2023-24 session (Even Semester, Semester-IV).
- 2) The students are required to give their preferences of VAC from the subject list. The college will allot the VAC subjects on a first come first serve basis. Students will not be allowed to change their VAC subjects at a later stage. Therefore, **follow extreme care while choosing the options, as college does not guarantee for the allotment of the chosen preferences.**
- 3) Students are advised to go through the Syllabi of the Value-Added Courses (VAC) before choosing their options. The Syllabi are uploaded on the portal for your reference.
- 4) **Students cannot opt for the same paper in Semester IV which they have studied in any of the previous semester (Semester I, II, or III).** For example: if the student has studied the VAC Paper "Financial Literacy" in any of the previous semester (Semester I, II, or III) then he/she cannot opt the same paper in Semester IV.
- 5) **The students will be held responsible in case of any false/misleading information on their part.**

Guidelines for SEC Semester IV

- 1) It is mandatory for all the students of all courses of Semester IV to choose their options for Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) that they want to opt for the 2023-24 session (Even semester, Semester-IV).
- 2) The students are required to give their preferences of SEC from the subject list. The college will allot the SEC subjects on a first come first serve basis. Students will not be allowed to change their SEC subjects at a later stage. Therefore, **follow extreme care while choosing their options, as college does not guarantee for the allotment of the chosen preferences.**
- 3) Students are advised to go through the Syllabi of the Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) before choosing their options. The Syllabi are uploaded on the portal for your reference.
- 4) **Students cannot opt for the same paper in Semester IV which they have studied in any of the previous semester (Semester I, II, or III).** For example: if the student has studied the SEC Paper "Digital Marketing" in any of the previous semester (Semester I, II, or III), then he/she cannot opt the same paper in Semester IV.
- 5) **The students will be held responsible in case of any false/misleading information on their part.**





Guidelines for AEC Semester IV

- 1) It is mandatory for all the students of all courses of Semester IV to study one Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) in 2023-24 session (Even semester, Semester-IV).
- 2) Students will not be allowed to change their AEC subjects at a later stage. Therefore, **follow extreme care while choosing their options**, as college does not guarantee for the allotment of the chosen preferences.
- 3) Students are advised to go through the Syllabi of the Ability Enhancement Course (AEC), before choosing their options. The Syllabi are uploaded on the portal for your reference.
- 4) **Students of BSc (Hons) Mathematics, BA (Hons) Economics, BA (Hons) English, BA (Hons) Geography, BA (Hons) Hindi, BA (Hons) History, BA (Hons) Political Science, BA Program, Semester IV (UGCF:2023-2024) will study an Indian Language - Course II as their compulsory AEC.** Shaheed Bhagat Singh College offers only Hindi as AEC Indian Language on the following basis:
Hindi A (For the students who have studied Hindi up to Class XII)
Hindi B (For the students who have studied Hindi up to Class X)
Hindi C (For the students who have studied Hindi up to Class VIII or Below)
- 5) Semester IV students are informed that if they wish to study any AEC Indian language (other than Hindi), they are required to send an email at sbsc.sec@sbs.du.ac.in mentioning your Roll Number, Course, Contact Number, and AEC paper that you wish to study in Semester IV. In case the student opts for an AEC-Indian Language not offered by Shaheed Bhagat Singh College, then he/she will have to attend classes in any other college belonging to the Cluster Colleges (South Campus) of the University of Delhi. The fulfillment of the choice of the student depends on the terms and conditions set by the host college.
- 6) **The students of B.Com (Hons.) and B.Com (Program) Semester IV (UGCF:2023-2024) are informed that they will study Environmental Science: Theory into Practice - Course II as their compulsory AEC.**
- 7) **The students will be held responsible in case of any false/misleading information on their part.**
