

Dr. Ashwani Agnihotri is a geographer and civil engineer by training, currently serving as an Assistant Professor in Geography at Shaheed Bhagat Singh College, University of Delhi. He earned his undergraduate degree from CSJM University, Kanpur, and his postgraduate degree from Banaras Hindu University, Varanasi. He further obtained an M.Tech from the University of Madras, Chennai, and completed his Ph.D. at the Indian Institute of Technology (BHU), Varanasi.

Dr. Agnihotri's research focuses on fluvial geomorphology, remote sensing and GIS analysis, InSAR time series analysis, and drone-based imaging and data analysis. He served as a Senior Project Associate at the Indian Institute of Technology, Kanpur.

His contributions to geospatial sciences earned him the Young Geospatial Scientist Award and the Rachapudi Kamakshi Memorial Gold Medal in 2019 at Geosmart India. He has also received the UGC Doctoral Fellowship and travel grants for conferences in Thailand and Dubai.
