Dr. Nain holds a Ph.d in “Spatio-temporal Analysis of Agricultural Infrastructure and its Impact on Agricultural Development: A Case Study of Mewat Region”. Dr. Nain Research examines of Agricultural Infrastructure and its Impact on Agricultural Development with a Case Study of Mewat Region. It is a small region covering southern Haryana and north-eastern Rajasthan. The main thrust of the study was to understand the existing disparities in the agricultural infrastructure particularly in irrigation, power, transport, banking, agricultural mechanisation extension services, veterinary, and health infrastructure. The important aspect of the study was to find out spatio-temporal variation to understand which of the pockets of region lagging behind and which area is growing faster and sees the impact of agricultural infrastructure on agricultural productivity.

He has published notable research on Agricultural Infrastructure Development, Regional Development, Outmigration and Himalayan Ecosystem.
